Run Winchcombe

This year will be the 10th anniversary of Run Winchcombe and there will be special medals to mark the occasion. Also new this year will be the introduction of chip timing. There will be 3 races on the day, the 10k Hill Climb, Sudeley 5k Fun Run and the Kids 1k run. Please see the full details below.



10k Hill Climb - 10.30am

The multi-terrain route climbs over 650 feet to the Neolithic long barrow Belas Knap with spectacular views. The run is open to those aged 15 and over with a closing date for pre-entries of 23rd August. The entry fee in advance is £8 club affiliated and £10 unaffiliated. On the day, the entry fee is £10 club affiliated and £12 unaffiliated (by 10am). There will be limited entries on the day with a maximum 200 for the 10K run.

Sudeley Fun Run (5K approx) - 10.30am

The run is suitable for all abilities aged 11 and over with a closing date for pre-entries of 23rd August. The entry fee will be £5 with limited entries on the day.

Kids 1K - 10.00am

The 1K run is for all children aged 10 and under with entries on the day only (£1). There will be a medal for all finishers.

Stalls

There are still some stalls available at the show. The cost of a stall is £40 which gives you a pitch of approximately 6m x 4.5m. If you are interested would you please contact Christine Dickson at stalls@winchcombeshow.org.uk.
